State of School Overview from our Principals

- The pattern of COVID exposure at LVE has been isolated cases. The communication with families and contact tracing protocols are working well. The children are thriving overall and they will continue to get as much time outside throughout the winter.
- SEPTA meeting Suggestion for guidance counselors to put out resources for children and technology and "digital citizenship." Guidance counselors visiting classrooms at LVI discussing how to be proactively kind to one another online.
- Holiday Celebrations AMP Winter Wonderland photo shoot and class parties with crafts and pre-packaged snacks, LVI streaming Holiday Light Festival. Ms. Huber has organized a sing along for each class to participate separately. Ms. Joyce organized a "Wish Tree" read aloud, teachers and staff each read a chapter. Students hang wishes in a tree in front of school.
- Building Community between AMP & LVI Site based team new initiative for parents, teachers, and students to build a cohesive experience K-5. Idea for Slogan: Community/Inclusivity/Connectivity. Idea for reading buddies, for example pairing 1st & 4th graders. Idea for new families coming in to all have a similar "on-boarding" experience.
- Google Breakout Room Teachers using for small group instruction and read aloud in the classroom
- Teachers College LV has invested heavily in the literacy program for students, phonics program new this year, and professional development for teachers. Also considering "professional development" guidance series for parents... look for info in upcoming weekly Friday emails.

 - #1 Report Cards Less ground covered thank in a typical marking period.
 Priority has been to emphasize literacy and math. Tried to be creative to maximize time in school to align science and social studies requirements with literacy-based research. This takes collaboration and planning and is a work in progress.
 - #2 Takeaways from NWEA assessments Using the data to help teachers to create a student's learning profile. Data has been helpful but will be more useful with more data points from our students.
